## Child Development Associate Program (CDA)

Briya’s Child Development Associate (CDA) program prepares students to work as early childhood educators in child development centers and home-based child development programs with children ages 0-5.

\*In addition to completing the course, students need to fulfill 480-hour practicum in a licensed childcare center or school, create a professional portfolio, and pass the CDA exam.

## Medical Assistant Program (MA)

Students train for careers working alongside doctors and nurses in medical offices, clinics, and hospitals. Students prepare to earn a nationally recognized Registered Medical Assistant credential.

\*In addition to completing the course, students need to fulfill 160-hour externship in a local clinic, hospital or doctor’s office, and pass the nationally recognized Registered Medical Assistant exam.
